Bridge Funding Match Policy
Office of Research & Scholarship March 2019

The Office of the Associate Provost of Research & Scholarship (APRS), in partnership with colleges and schools/departments, provides short-term support to maintain critical elements of active scholarly programs during a gap in external funding support, until additional funding is obtained. This funding mechanism is considered a last resort for internal funding that budget limits may restrict the APRS from providing.

Applications will **only** be considered if they contain support from the PI's Department and College. Bridge funds will not be used to cover faculty salary. Instead, the funds are intended to cover key components of the funded project such as salaries for graduate students/post-docs/technicians, costs associated with animal housing and care, critical supplies, and other such core research elements.

Bridge funds are limited in duration to 1 year.

Application Process
